- 1. KBIT II Intelligence Test Score
- 2. MAPs test scores
- 3. Teacher referral
 - A student will qualify with these requirements:
 - a. Standardized Intelligence Test Score equal or above 130 or
 - b. Total points equal of above 16 points
- 4. A team of teachers, administrators, counselor, and curriculum specialist evaluate students' scores for their placement into the gifted and talented program.
- 5. After a child is identified as gifted, the parents are contacted. Then students will be assessed on their strengths and interests.
